Accountability: The <u>Intern</u> reports directly to the Director of Program Innovation. Additionally, they may receive oversight from the Executive Director of Bellwether Farm and the Bishop of The Episcopal Diocese of Ohio.

Principal Responsibilities:

- 1. The Intern will serve as our behind-the-scenes crew, assisting in whatever ways the director and assistant director deems fit
- 2. Assist with meal clean up and organization, purchasing, and handing out of all snack times
- 3. Take photos and videos of camp activities (Ensure footage is taken of all camp activities throughout the session)
- 4. Create and Prepare all nametags by cabin for each upcoming session
- 5. Organize t-shirts by cabin for each upcoming session
- 6. Assist the directors in coordinating LIT schedules and contacting them with up-to-date information about their arrival and departure times for each session
- 7. Present on the weekends/ the night before the camp sessions to greet the LITs and get them settled in their spaces and ready for the week.
- 8. Organize and store the best pictures and videos throughout the summer on a hard drive
- 9. Coordinate and organize photos and materials daily
- 10. Make slideshow video with music of each session to be shared with the entire camp on closing day
- 11. Upload, and filter through each session's photos and update session
- 12. Maintain, care for, and be responsible for all technology, cameras, and gear

- 13. Take cabin pictures of the cabin every campfire night
- 14. Create a staff video throughout the summer to be shown at end of summer staff banquet
